

## Winners' Camp Foundation (WCF) Emergency Procedures

WCF creates a safe supportive environment for all participants. We are constantly upgrading our safety and security measures.

1. WCF has the direct number to the Hawai'i Kai Fire Department that connects fire house, enabling us to bypass 911. WCF has a direct cellular connection with Todd Hugo, a firefighter at the Hawai'i Kai Fire Department.
2. In the unlikely event of an emergency we are less than 15 minutes away from the Straubb Medical and Emergency Room Clinic.
3. During sessions there is enough water and food stored at camp for sixty people to live on for 10 days.
4. There are strategically placed fire extinguishers, which are in compliance with regulations, in every building. We are in compliance with smoke detector regulations.
5. All buildings are equipped with diagrams that show: the layout of the buildings, the evacuation plan, and the positions of the fire extinguishers and smoke detectors.
6. Camp grounds has a four corners surveillance system to ensure safety and appropriate behavior.

### Precautions:

- The bottom gate to WCF is kept locked.
- The 2<sup>nd</sup> gate, at the main entrance, is also kept locked.
- Security checks are conducted nightly by WCF staff.
- All staff are professionally trained before camp in, "Maintaining and Creating a Safe Environment."
- There are CPR certified staff on-call and present at all times.
